



## People to People International

### Joyce C. Hall College Scholarship Application

#### 2010-2011 Academic Year

The family of Mr. Joyce C. Hall, founder of Hallmark Cards, Inc., made a gift to People to People International from his estate. Some of the income from this fund is available for college scholarships in order to encourage youth participation in international activities.

The scholarships are \$2,000.00 each and up to five (5) will be selected for the 2010-2011 academic year. Each award will be sent directly to the student's university and administered by the university. The scholarship must be used to pay tuition first, then books and supplies. People to People International must approve application of scholarship funds to meet other educational expenses such as dormitory fees, off-campus study; special projects, etc.

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### Requirements

1. Applicants must have had experience with People to People International through participation in one of our various programs, such as the Student Ambassador Program, student or adult chapter activities, School and Classroom Program, Global Youth Forum, etc. This experience must have been within the past four years. Applicants must be a current member of People to People International.
  - A statement of the applicants's participation in a People to People International activity, and what that experience meant to increasing his/her understanding of inter-cultural relations among the peoples of the world. For example, did that experience alter previous concepts? If so, in what way?
  - An original essay on "Why I believe international friendships are important and how my experiences have increased my understanding of people from other countries/cultures." No more than 1,000 words please. Essays longer than 1,000 words will be automatically disqualified.
2. The applicant must currently be a high school senior or a full-time college or university student and must maintain a 3.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale.
3. The application form must be accompanied by:
  - Statement of Financial Need Form
  - Three letters of recommendation from people who know you well. Probable sources include Student Ambassador delegation leaders; chapter presidents; high school teachers and/or college faculty members. Letters require a title or explanation of the individual's relationship to you. When possible, the letters should be on letterhead stationary and sealed.
  - A transcript from the school is required.
4. High school seniors applying must prove they are actively applying to colleges or universities. Scholarships will not be finalized until proof of college acceptance has been received at PTPI World Headquarters.
5. All information must be provided in one envelope. Incomplete and late applications will not be considered. Applications must be received by October 15, 2009. Recipients will be announced no later than January, 2010.

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### Eligibility

Applicants who have already been awarded the Joyce C. Hall College Scholarship are unable to reapply. You may only receive the scholarship one time and the scholarship is not renewable.

Employees, Officers, Trustees and Directors of People to People International and their respective families are not eligible to apply for the Joyce C. Hall Scholarship.
