### WHAT IS GLOBAL YOUTH MURALS ON TOUR?

Global Youth Murals on Tour is an opportunity for People to People International (PTPI) Chapters to host an exhibit of PTPI's extraordinary Global Youth Murals. By signing up for this initiative, your chapter will receive 15 Global Youth Murals to display in your community for one-two months. Your chapter is responsible for mailing the murals to the next Host Chapter or returning the artwork to PTPI World Headquarters.

People to People International's School & Classroom Program has linked more than 275,000 students and their teachers in 128 countries for pen pal exchanges and projects that foster cultural understanding and friendship. PTPI's School & Classroom Program invites children annually to participate in the Global Youth Murals project. Students ages 4-19 years old create artwork that illustrates our world's unique cultures, hope for friendship and peace, and the importance of making people-to-people connections.
